

These graphics show that even when there are more allochtonen rounding up their education, even more than autochtonen, the niet-westerse allochtonen have a decreased income.

Discrimination has many ways and mechanisms, but it is certain that if a segment of the population increases its education level meanwhile its income decreases, a social process of exclusion from the better paid jobs is going on.

Given the data that the CBS makes publicly available, this study should call the attention of the politicians to further detailed studies.
